Instructions for authors

1. *Manuscripts* should be written in German or English, they must be typewritten on one side only of the paper, double-spaced throughout with a margin of at least 3 cm on the left and right side. The manuscripts should not exceed 25 typewritten pages (including figures and tables) and the number of figures and tables should be limited to the essential minimum.

Manuscripts should be submitted ready for printing; authors will be charged for any corrections except those of misprints.

For measurement and weight indications please use the metric system only.

Accentuation typefaces:

==== double underline signifies **boldface** (e.g. for titles or subtitles, volume numbers in the references)

~~~~ wavy underline signifies *italics* for genus and species, not for families and higher categories, also for accentuation of words in the text or subtitles

blocks of text which are less important are to be marked by the author for small print = wavy line in the margin

2. *Composition* of manuscripts:

*Title* of the paper.

*Complete first and surname(s)* of the author(s) as well as name(s) and address(es) of the research institute(s) respectively address(es).
