### • Stability of an intravenous fat emulsion containing 6% propofol and a low amount of emulsifier

A new formulation Propofol 6% has been developed in order to reduce the fat load, amount of emulsifier and volume for the patient. Evaluation of the quality and safety of this formulation, by focussing on the tail of the globule size distribution and guided by suggested size limits.

### • Factors contributing to the extent of the carbamazepine-erythromycin interaction

The level of contamination of the environment by cyclophosphamide in drug reconstitution units of 21 Italian hospitals was measured. Contamination levels were quite low on floors but became approximately ten times higher on the hoods of working trays.

### • Cyclophosphamide environmental contamination in drug reconstitution units in twenty one Italian hospitals

A retrospective analysis was undertaken dealing with the available case reports concerning the interaction between carbamazepine and erythromycin and the observations were compared to those obtained by means of in vitro or clinical studies.

### • Analysis of medication errors detected in the dispensing process by the unit dose system in a Spanish hospital

This research was carried out to detect, describe, calculate and assess errors produced by a pharmacy department when giving out drugs by the Unit Dose Dispensing System. The results are discussed.
