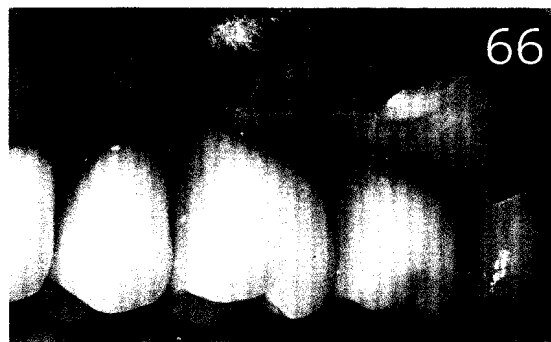


Schematic representation: A perforation of the sinus membrane is sealed with a collagen membrane and two titanium pins.
