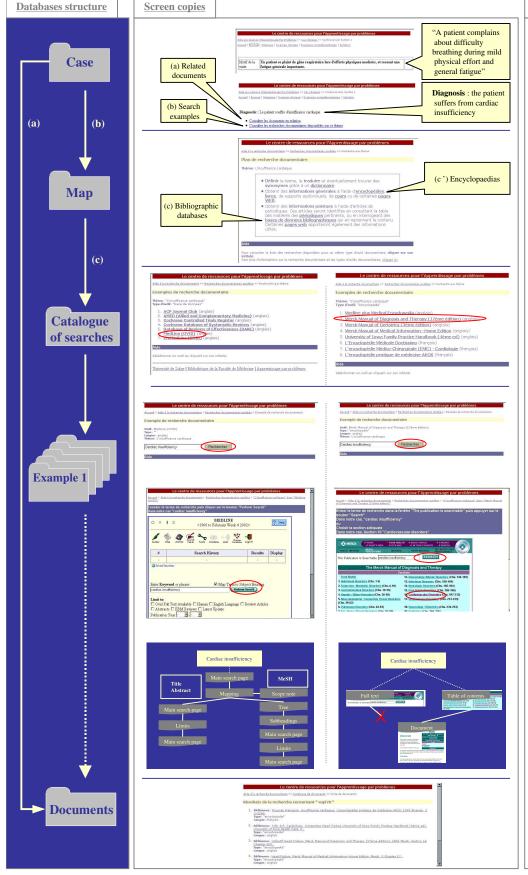


An information retrieval training tool targeting the PBL students at the University of Liege



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Commentary

- •A clinical case provides a context for the searches.
- •Information concerning the case are stored in a database.
- •The diagnosis provides 2 links.
- •A search map classifies the resource types.
- •Each link selects the search examples concerning the subject of the clinical case in a particular resource type.
- •A catalogue lists the search examples conducted by librarians concerning cardiac insufficiency. There are currently twenty-two.
- •Users encode an appropriate keyword and, if relevant, access to the related guideline.
- •The guideline's window is composed of 2 elements.
- •A librarian's commentary explains how to use the resource and provides suggestions.
- •A screen copy of the real resource provides several areas to click on in order to reach the next step of the guideline.
- •At the end of the guideline, users are directed to the editor's Website.
- •Scenarios include several keywords searched with all available options.
- •Some options do not provide a relevant document.
- •All retrieved documents are catalogued in one database.
